- 14 – A plane crashes at the french-swiss border, where should the rescued ones be buried?
- 15 – Toto's sister has 4 brothers: Peter, Paul, Jack and ....?
- 16 – Knowing that George is born on a 29th of February and all the bissextile years come back every 4 years, what is – according to you – the percentage of chance that his birthyear was a bissextile year (= a leap-year)?
- 17 – Can you find somewhere a stone with the original inscription: 30BC? (*=Before Christ*)
- 18 – It takes Toto one hour and a half to go to school but only 90 minutes to come back home. How come? Can you find at least one explanation...
- 19 – There are 9 crows in a tree, a hunter comes and kills in quick succession 2 crows, how many crows are left in the tree?
- 20 – Does the 14th of July exist in England?
